Don't Judge Me (Part 3): Judgment and salvation

1. Write down at least one gospel encouragement and one challenge you got from this week's message.

2. Read 1 Corinthians 5:1-5. The Corinthians were celebrating the man's sin instead of confronting it? Why is their approach "easier" but lacking in love (see Mark 12:28-31)?
 - a. Consider your own relationships. Who do you need to have a loving conversation with?

 - b. According to verse 5, what is the goal of that conversation?

3. Read 1 Corinthians 5:9-13. Define what Paul means here by "judge".
 - a. As a Christian, whose words and actions are you to judge and for what purpose? Keeping in mind Matthew 7:1-5, what does that process look like?

4. Site examples from the Gospel accounts that show Jesus dealing with believers and unbelievers differently.



Car Conversations

1. How has God shown you love? Today? Last week? Last year?
2. What is the difference between loving in “words and speech” and loving in “action and truth”? Which kind of love have you been showing to others?
3. Read the following together: *“But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control” Galatians 5:22-23.* How can we as a family show God’s love this week? Pray for the Spirit’s guidance and power. Identify a person, make a plan and love him/her!
