3.	Evaluate: The key to judging Jesus' way is to constantly remember that God has had mercy on you, a sinner.
4.	Read James 5:19-20. What is your ultimate goal in helping someone remove the speck from their eye?
5.	If you call someone out for their sin and they respond, "Mind your own business. You've got your faults too!", how would you respond?

- 2. (Based on Numbers 13 and 14) Joshua and Caleb trusted God and then encouraged others to trust in Him. Who in your life needs encouragement? Pray for this person and think of ways you can encourage him/her this week.
