Faith Group Questions

Don't Judge Me (Part 4): The Church's Court

- 1. Read 1 Corinthians 6:1-11. In this section, Paul calls you a "Saint" (EHV) or one of "The Lord's People" (NIV). Explain why you feel comfortable or uncomfortable carrying this title?
 - a. As one of God's Saints, how can you help fellow Christians settle their disputes?
- 2. Why do you think it's easier or preferable for some Christians (maybe even yourself) to try to settle their disputes with other Christians in the court of law instead of in the Church?
- 3. How does airing our grievances in front of unbelievers (vs. 6) undermine what Jesus says in John 13:34-35 and what the inspired Paul writes in Ephesians 4:32-5:2?
- 4. Is there a dispute or case you need Christian guidance for? Share with your group and discuss.



- 1. What is the difference between happiness and joy? List off as many blessings as you can in 30 seconds. Review your list. Do these things give you happiness or joy?
- 2. What are some of the tough situations you faced in the past school year? Why can you still have joy?
- 3. Repeat together: "The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control" Galatians 5:22-23. At the end of each day this week, discuss the day's "highs and lows" (great and not-so-great moments of the day) and pray together, thanking God for our unshakeable joy because of Jesus.
