- 4. **Read Job 1:20-22** (Summarize Context). How can you apply Job's hallowing God's name in the face of adversity in your own life?
- 5. **Read Ezekiel 36:22-27**. What do these verses teach you about how God hallows his own name?
 - a. What do they teach you about how God hallows his name through you?



- 1. Think back to a situation when it was hard to show self-control. What made it difficult?
- 2. What is a promise of God that gives you comfort when you are tempted?
- 3. Think about specific temptations that you face. List them, and then review the list by saying aloud, "The Spirit is greater than (name your temptation)." Repeat this statement with each temptation you identified. Pray, thanking God for his Spirit who lives in you through faith in Jesus who strengthens you against these temptations.
