  - a. How have you or others you know come to similar conclusions?
- 3. Read 2 Corinthians 5:14-18. According to these verses, why did Jesus sacrifice his life for you?
  - a. What is the "worldly point of view" described in verse 16 and how does that compare with Ecclesiastes 1 & 2?
- 4. Think about the different aspects of your life (daily routine, work, relationships, etc.) How do they have meaning and purpose in light of Jesus' sacrifice for you?
- 5. CHALLENGE: This week, every time you go to class, study, or work, pray and dedicate your work to God and his glory; invite Jesus to be present with you and to work in you and through you.



- 1. Why was Esther an unlikely hero? Are you similar to Esther? How or how not?
- 2. God planted Esther to use her in a specific position for a very specific purpose. Where has God placed you? What purpose do you think God has for you?
