1. What from the worship service and message encouraged you and challenged you in your faith walk?

2. In Ecclesiastes 12, Solomon declared that it's the duty of all mankind to fear God and keep his commandments. Read Deuteronomy 10:12-13. According to these verses, why does God want you to fear him and obey his commandments?
 - a. Have you always viewed God's commands as good for you? Why or why not?

3. Read John 14:15-24. According to these verses, what does obeying or not obeying God's commands say about your relationship with him?
 - b. Give practical examples of why it's better to live your life following God's commands instead of following societal norms or the desires of your own heart.

4. Read through Exodus 20:1-26 and give examples of how Jesus kept every one of these commandments perfectly for you.

5. Conclude your group discussion asking for prayer requests.
