Generous (Part 1): The Grace of Giving

1. What were your main takeaways from the Sunday service and message?
2. Read 2 Corinthians 8:1-5. What about the Macedonian's generosity sticks out to you?
3. The Macedonian's pockets were empty, but their hearts were full of God's grace. Paul shared their story to motivate the Corinthians to grow in the grace of giving. Share a personal story about how someone else's generosity has encouraged you to be more generous.
4. Read 2 Corinthians 8:7. The Holy Spirit commands us, through Paul's writings, to excel in this grace of giving. What practical steps are you taking or would like to take to do this?
5. Read 2 Corinthians 8:9. The main word throughout these first nine verses is "grace". In what ways have you experienced the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ? (This is your time to brag about what your Savior has done for you!)



Car Conversations

1. What's the hardest thing you've ever had to do? (ex. learn to read, math, play an instrument, throw a fastball) How did you get through it? Who helped?
2. What do you do when you're in trouble or when someone makes fun of you?
3. Read Philippians 4:6-7. How does God want us to pray?
4. Weapon of Worship: What makes you worry? Take it to God in prayer together, praising Him for who He is, thanking him for what He has done and asking for peace.
