### *In the Beginning (Part 5): Sin, Death, Redemption*

1. What from the message directly applies to what's going on in your life right now?
  
2. Read Genesis 3:6-7. Adam and Eve doubted God's love for them and tried to usurp his authority. In what ways have you doubted God's love for you and tried or are trying to be like "God" by taking control of aspects of your life that you're not in control of?
  - a. What have been the negative consequences of your actions and what's the only solution?
  
3. Read Genesis 3:7-13. Adam and Eve unsuccessfully tried to cover up their sin, shame, and guilt. What self-made remedies have you tried using to cover up your sin, shame, and guilt and how has that worked out for you?
  
4. Read Psalm 32. According to this Psalm what do you need to stop doing, start doing, and what has God already done for you?
