Jesus is... (Part 4): Forgiving

- 1. Share some of your highs and lows from the last few weeks.
- 2. Read Mark 2:1-5. The paralyzed man wouldn't have gotten to Jesus without his friends putting their faith in action. Share a time when you were in a difficult situation and how someone putting their faith in action helped you find comfort from God.
- 3. Read Mark 2:5-8. The teachers of the law didn't believe that Jesus had the power to forgive sins. Define what it means to forgive someone's sins.
 - a. Do you believe that Jesus has the power to forgive your sins? Why or why not?
- 4. Read Mark 2:8-12. What's the answer to Jesus' question in verse 9?
 - a. What did Jesus prove about his ability to forgive your sins by healing the paralytic?
 - b. What else did Jesus do to prove that (provide Bible passages)?
- 5. How do you practically extend God's forgiveness to others who have sinned against you?



Keep the conversation with your kids going using these questions based on the Faith Kids' lesson.

- 1. What do you think "suffering" means?
- 2. What are some thoughts you might think in your head when you're suffering?
- 3. What do you think is the most helpful thing for someone who is suffering?
- 4. When you're going through a tough time, what do you think Jesus wants to say to you?
- 5. Name a few people you think can encourage you when you're suffering. Together with one of those people find a Bible verse that is comforting to you.
