Jesus is... (Part 5): for Everyone

1. Read Mark 2:13-15. Because Levi and his friends were tax collectors they were rejected by the religious community. Was there ever a time when you or someone you know didn't feel accepted by the religious community? Explain.
 - a. What does Jesus calling Levi and the other tax collectors and sinners to follow him teach us about the character and mission of Jesus?
 - b. Give other examples from the Bible when Jesus/God called people who seemed unworthy to be part of his family.
 - c. What does all this mean for you and your relationship with God?
2. Read Mark 2:16. What sort of Pharisee-like tendencies are in your heart?
 - a. Why is it important to remember that you are saved by God's grace when relating to other people?
3. Read Mark 2:17. How might you use this verse to help your friend who says, "I don't go to church because churches are full of hypocrites"?

1. What do you think the disciples thought of Jesus' instructions regarding the donkey?
2. Why were the people on the streets so excited to see Jesus? How would their reaction have changed if they knew that Jesus was going to die?
3. What does it mean that Jesus wants to be King of your heart?
4. How will you praise King Jesus this week?
