

Faith Group Questions

Rooted in Christ (Part 1): Spirit Filled

1. Read Colossians 1:1-6. The Apostle Paul prayed for and thanked God for his fellow Christians. Take time this week to pray for and thank God for each of your Group members individually and look for opportunities to let them know you're praying for them (call, text, email, etc.).
 - a. Why do you think regularly praying for and thanking God for your fellow Christians is a helpful way for maintaining unity?

2. Reread vs. 6. Why is it important to rejoice in what God is doing not only in your life or your local church but throughout the world?

3. Read Colossians 9:7-8. A man named Epaphras led many of the Colossians to Christ. Who is someone who led you to Christ or has helped you grow in your relationship with him? If that person is still alive, take some time this week to reach out to them and thank them for sharing Jesus with you. Share your story with your group.

4. Read Colossians 9:9-14. Make a list of all the spiritual blessings Paul was praying for the Colossians. Which of them stands out to you the most and why?



Car Conversations

Keep the conversation with your kids going using these questions based on the Faith Kids' lesson.

1. Describe the best party you've ever attended.
2. How do you think Martha felt at the party? How do you think Mary felt?
3. What does peace feel like?
4. What good things do you think Jesus' gift of peace does?
5. What are some things that might keep you from feeling Jesus' gift of peace?
