Faith Group Questions

Rooted in Christ (Part 2): The Supremacy of Christ

1.	What specific ways have you seen God bless you recently?
2.	In what area of your life or situation has it been hard to put Christ first?
3.	Read Colossians 1:15-23. What immediately stands out to you? Does anything in these verses particularly confuse you, encourage you or convict you?
4.	As the 'image of God,' Jesus is God's exact representation. What God is, Jesus is. What God contains, Jesus contains. What God has, Jesus has. What God does, Jesus does. In every way that God is God, Jesus' being exactly (fully/perfectly) represents God's being. How does Jesus' own teaching in John 5:16-30 and John 14:1-14 back up this claim?
5.	How would you answer someone who genuinely asked, "Who is Jesus"?
6.	How to you think putting Jesus back on his throne and focusing on who he truly is will benefit your thoughts, priorities, behaviors, and relationships?



Keep the conversation with your kids going using these questions based on the Faith Kids' lesson.

- 1. Have you ever been stuck in a really crowded room? How did it make you feel?
- 2. How can you tell when you need to take a break and do something to calm down?
- 3. What are some things you are good at doing to take care of yourself?
- 4. Jesus had a very busy schedule with many important things to do, but his relationship with his Father was always most important. How do you know this?
- 5. What can you do to feel God's peace? (Look up Philippians 4:6-7) Make a list of things you can thank God for. Pray to Him and get some peace!
