Rooted in Christ (Part 4): From Death to Life

1. Read Colossians 2:6-7. Thankfulness is a main theme of each of Paul's letters. Make an "overflowing" list of all the blessings you're thankful for and share them with your group?
2. Read Colossians 2:8. Continuing in the faith requires being resistant to spiritual lies and remaining true to biblical teachings. What are some of the more obvious heresies/falsehoods in our society that seek to undermine true Christian spirituality and faith in Jesus? What are some of the more subtle philosophies and human traditions that all too easily creep into the church and into our lives as Christians?
3. Read Colossians 2:9-10. What do these verses mean and why are they so important to remember?
4. Read Colossians 2:11-15. What are the similarities and differences between circumcision and baptism?
5. What ongoing spiritual benefits does God give you through your baptism?
6. What advice would you give to someone who doesn't "feel forgiven" or has remaining guilt or shame over sins they have already repented of?

2. How was Abigail a peacemaker?
3. When is it easy to be a peacemaker? When is it hard?
