Communion

1. Share with the group something from the message that resonated with you and discuss.
2. Read 1 Corinthians 11:17-34. Is Communion an individual thing we do in worship to God or a corporate thing (or both)? How do we know this from these verses?
3. This section highlights the pride and disunity that the Corinthian church was experiencing. How can receiving Communion regularly and meditating on what it truly means help us to maintain unity within our church family?
4. Imagine you're talking to someone who is not familiar with Christianity and its practices but is interested and they ask about what communion is all about. How would you describe it to them and what it points to?
5. Practically speaking, what are some good habits we can implement to keep Communion from becoming an empty ritual and to make sure we're going to the Lord's Table in a worthy manner?

1. Who is someone you know who is a good listener? What makes someone a good listener?
