Rooted in Christ (Part 8): Seasoned with Salt

1. Share with the group something from the message that resonated with you and discuss.

2. Read Colossians 4:2. Break down this passage. What does devoting yourself to prayer look like?
 - a. What does it mean to be watchful in prayer? (see Matthew 26:36-46).

 - b. What does it look like for you to be thankful in prayer?

3. In your experience, what have been the results of you devoting OR not devoting time to prayer?

4. Read Colossians 4:3-4. Paul was in prison when he wrote this prayer request. What did he ask for and what didn't he ask for?
 - a. How is this similar or different from your prayer requests and what can you learn from his?

5. Read Colossians 4:5-6. Define what "outsiders" means and who are the "outsiders" you interact with?
 - a. With God's help, and according to these verses, how can you get better at making the most of every opportunity with outsiders?



Car Conversations

Keep the conversation with your kids going using these questions based on the Faith Kids' lesson.

1. What does patience mean? When is it hard for you to show patience at home? At school? While praying with friends?
2. Who is someone you know that is patient?
3. What did Hannah do when she was sad and troubled?
4. Will God always give us what we ask for in prayer? What does this tell you about God?
5. What are you patiently waiting for right now? How can you worship God while you wait for Him to answer your prayer?
