

Growth Group Questions

PRAY

1. Read Psalm 12:1-4. Do you share similar frustrations with David concerning the current climate surrounding public education, politics, religion, secular media, and interpersonal relationships? Get it off your chest and make your list like David did and then talk it out with the group.

2. SELF-ASSESS. While it's easy to see the problems the outside world is causing, it's also important to reflect on our own sinful faults. In what ways have you been unfaithful, disloyal, a lying neighbor, flattering others while harboring deceit, or prideful?

3. Read Psalm 12:5. What does the LORD's response reveal about His heart towards what's going on in the world in general and in your world specifically?
 - a. Read Romans 8:18-25. How can use these words for your own personal comfort and for the comfort of others?

4. Read Psalm 12:6-8. In contrast to the lying world, the LORD's word is flawless. With this knowledge how can we address the spiritual decline of our culture?



Car Conversations

Keep the conversation with your kids going using these questions based on the Faith Kids' lesson.

1. Share about a time when you desperately needed help.
2. David ran towards what should have been his fear. What does this tell you about His God?
3. How is David similar to Jesus?
4. Are you afraid of anything right now or is there anything that makes you nervous? Pray to David's God and your God who *is alive* and who has *all power*.
