## Core Values Part 3: REPENTANCE & FORGIVENESS

- 1. What does it mean to repent?
  - a. Are you currently living a life of repentance towards God or a life of rebellion against God?
- 2. Read Psalm 32. What did God do for King David when he repented of his rebellion?
  - a. God offers you the same forgiveness and mercy that he gave to King David. Apply the words of Psalm 32 to your own situation.
- 3. Ephesians 4:32 says, "Forgive each other, just as in Christ God forgave you." How and how much has God forgiven you?
  - a. Now, think about those who have hurt you, sinned against you, made your life more difficult and meditate on how God would like you to treat them.
  - b. Jesus' suffering and dying on the cross to forgive you your sins was not easy. Just like it's not easy for you to forgive someone who has sinned against you. But, by faith you have the power of Jesus living inside of you. Ask Jesus through prayer to help you forgive those who have hurt you.



## Keep the conversation with your kids going using these questions based on the Faith Kids' lesson.

- 1. What does it take to be a good neighbor? Name a good neighbor and share what he or she has done to be a good neighbor.
- 2. Who are you most like in the story that Jesus told? Who is most like Jesus in the story?
- 3. When you follow Jesus and you're a part of God's Church, who's your neighbor?
- 4. How do you think you can be a good neighbor to someone you don't like or who's mean to you?
- 5. Name someone you know who needs help, needs a friend, or who is hurt. What can you do this week to be a good neighbor to them?
