- 1. What was the early church devoted to in Acts 2:42-47?
 - a. What risk does our church face if any one of the four areas in vs.42 is neglected?
 - b. How else did the early church express community life in practical ways?
- 2. Read Romans 12:10-15 and Hebrews 10:23-25. What elements of community do you see emphasized in these passages?
 - a. What elements of community do you see demonstrated here at Faith Church?
- 3. What obstacles get in the way of our devotion to community life? How can we push against the individualism of our culture and false sense of community we have through technology?
- 4. The early church saw themselves as a single family. Just as a biological family would share shelter, food, and money, so did the early church. In what ways can we share our lives with other believers, materially and otherwise? Do you have a personal example?



Keep the conversation with your kids going using these questions based on the Faith Kids' lesson.

- 1. What was your favorite (or worst) fishing trip or experience?
- 2. In the Bible story, Jesus taught His first disciples to fish for people. How can you learn to fish for people today?
- 3. How do you think people can tell that you follow Jesus?
- 4. What do you think happens when you tell people about Jesus, but you don't live God's way? What is God's solution to when you don't live His way?
- 5. What might keep you from sharing about Jesus with people?
- 6. Faith in Action!: Identify someone who you could share Jesus with this week. Pray for this person. Ask the Spirit to give you an opportunity to talk about Jesus with this person and the boldness to share about God's love.
