Core Values Part 5: OUTWARD FOCUSSED

1. Read 1 Corinthians 9:19-23. Explain, in your own words, what Paul meant when he said, "I have become all things to all people."
2. What about yourself do you find to be your greatest challenge when trying to find common ground with other people?
3. Read Romans 5:6-11 and meditate on what Jesus did in order to win your soul. What do you envision when you think about trying to win someone to Jesus?
4. Paul mentions "by all possible means." What are some "possible means" that you haven't tried yet that could potentially help you lead someone to Jesus? Pray for God's guidance.
5. You can't win over everyone you interact with, but with God's help you can win one. Who's the "one" in your life that needs to be "won"?



Car Conversations

Keep the conversation with your kids going using these questions based on the Faith Kids' lesson.

1. Do you know anyone who lives far away? Is that hard? How do you stay close to him or her?

2. Sharing Jesus with the whole world is too hard for one person to do alone. Why do you think God gave us a mission like that?

3. How do you think friends who follow Jesus are like a cord of three strands? Who do you think the third strand is? (see the next question for help)
 - a. "Therefore go and make disciples of all nations. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age." What promise does Jesus make to you as you do his work?

 - b. How does this promise make you feel?

4. Identify one place in your "world". How can you continue God's mission in your "world" this week?
