Healthy Relationships Part 5: Sexual Purity

1. What comforted and what challenged you from God's word shared in the message?

2. Read 1 Corinthians 6:12-20. What cultural mantras were the Corinthian Christians allowing to guide their thoughts about sexuality?
 - a. What are some modern-day mantras about sexuality that may have influenced you or people you love that are antibiblical?

3. What has God revealed to you in these verses concerning sexual purity?

4. Whether we feel comfortable talking about it or not, sexual sins are commonplace within our culture. Therefore, it's wise for us to discuss "how to flee from sexual immorality." Read Genesis 39:6-12 and Matthew 5:27-30 then discuss practical ways to "run from" and "cut off" habits or situations that may cause someone to fall into these temptations.

5. Satan wants you and me to believe that if we fall or have fallen into sexual temptation, there is no way that God will forgive us or redeem our situation. Read the following passages and explain what God actually says and does.
 - a. 1 Corinthians 6:9-11
 - b. John 8:1-11
 - c. Matthew 21:28-32

2. Read: Acts 20:22-24 What does Paul mean when he says, "compelled by the Spirit"?

4. How do we know that what we believe God is telling us to do is really from God?
5. Would you be willing to go somewhere for Jesus knowing that you could be put in prison and face all kinds of difficulties? Why?
