3.	What comforting solutions does Jesus give to your worries in verses 25-32?
	a. Describe a time when our Heavenly Father showed up and provided for you in your need.
4.	Read Matthew 6:33-34. What does it mean to seek first God's kingdom?
	a. What is Jesus telling you to do in verse 34?



Keep the conversation with your kids going using these questions based on the Faith Kids' lesson.

- 1. How does it feel when you get chosen for something? What have you been chosen for? Was there ever a time you didn't get chosen for something?
- 2. Why do you think Peter asked Jesus to "go away" from him at first?
