- 2. Share something that stood out to you from the message or Scripture readings and discuss with the group.
- 3. Read 1 Chronicles 29:10-12. What do you learn about God from these verses, and think about how this should impact your relationship with HIM?
- 4. Read 1 Chronicles 20:13-17. What do you learn about yourself, and about your possessions from these verses?
 - a. What is the result of willingly giving back to God what is already God's?
- 5. Read 1 Chronicles 20:18. Write your own personal prayer based off of this verse and post it somewhere where you can see it and pray it regularly. Share it with your group.



Keep the conversation with your kids going using these questions based on the Faith Kids' lesson.

- 1. What have you been put in charge of (or had "authority" over) before?
- 2. How do you think the man's life changed after Jesus forgave and healed him?
