Forgotten God Part 1: The Promised Holy Spirit

1. Read John 15:26-27. What does it mean that the Holy Spirit is your Advocate?

2. Read John 16:1-6. In what ways and by what groups have you observed Jesus' warnings being fulfilled today?
 - a. Knowing God the Father and God the Son are what keep people from living their lives in ignorance. What is the warning for you and me?

 - b. How does this highlight the importance of us testifying about Jesus to others (see John 15:26-27)?

3. Read John 16:7-11. Break down what it means that the Holy Spirit came to prove the world wrong about sin, righteousness, and judgment.
 - a. In the Christian Church we sometimes wish that Jesus never left this world, but why is it good for us that he did?

4. Read John 16:12-15. Using these verses, summarize the main roles and purposes of God the Holy Spirit.

Keep the conversation with your kids going using these questions based on the Faith Kids' lesson.

(The following questions are based on 1 Thessalonians 1:3 & Hebrews 12:2)

1. What is a goal you hope to reach?
2. What do you think makes wishing different from hoping?
3. What hope did Jesus have to complete the difficult tasks that His Heavenly Father called Him to do? (Read Hebrews 12:2 together)
4. How do you think hope in Jesus helps someone do things that are difficult?
5. Why does Jesus give you hope?
6. How can you help someone have hope and help him/her reach his/her goals?
