Forgotten God Part 2: Speaks Through His People

1. Read Acts 2:14-15. Why did some of the crowd believe that the apostles and Jesus' other followers were drunk on the day of Pentecost? Read the first 13 verses to explain why their assessment didn't make any sense.

2. Read Acts 2:16-21. Which part of Joel's prophecy pertained to what was going on during the Pentecost celebration? Which part pertains to Christ's second coming?
 - a. How do verses 17-19 apply to you and the Global Christian Church today?

3. Define what it means to prophesy AND according to vss. 21-24 what's the main goal of prophesying?
 - a. Who has God placed in your life that you get to prophesy to?

4. If you have a dream or a vision, how can you determine if it's from God? (See Acts 16:6-10).

1. "May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit." Romans 15:13
 - a. What do you like about this Bible verse?
 - b. How do you think someone without hope might feel?
 - c. What do you think might make a kid lose his/her hope?

2. How did Jesus give the woman at the well hope in John chapter 4?
 - a. What did the woman do with that hope?
 - b. How has Jesus given you hope?
 - c. With whom will you share hope this week and how will you share hope with this person?
