This Is The Bible Part 3: Using the Truth to Fight Temptations

1. Unlike Jesus in the wilderness, we do not have to fight temptation alone. Who are two or three fellow Christians that you can reach out to when temptation is fierce? If you can't think of any, pray for the courage to invite others into your spiritual life.
2. Read the other accounts of Jesus' temptation in Matthew 4:1-11 and Mark 1:12-13. What do Matthew and Mark add to your understanding of Jesus' temptation?
3. "Man shall not live on bread alone." How do Jesus' words help free you from needing more and more physical things (aka "bread") so that you can become a generous giver?

1. What's interesting about this Bible verse to you?
2. What's the point in learning about Bible heroes who made a lot of bad choices and mistakes?
3. How is Jesus different from every other Bible hero?
4. What do you think kids can learn from reading about Jesus in the Bible?
5. What changes about a person who follows Jesus? Why is this change possible?
6. How can God use you this week to be a "hero of faith" to someone in your life?
