1.	Read 2 Kings 7:3-8. What does this account demonstrate to you about God's strength and power to work in your life?
2.	Read 2 Kings 7:9-11. The lepers realized that they were sinning by hoarding the supplies and keeping the good news to themselves. What good things has God been doing in your life and who can you share that news with?
3.	Read 2 Kings 7:12-16. The king and his men demonstrated that some people will receive your good news with skepticism and may not believe you unless they do their own thorough investigation. Look up the following passages and summarize how they emphasize the truth of "Obey God and leave the results up to him."

- 5. What does Pastor Paul say you can do for people who aren't kind (Romans 12:17-21)?
- 6. Loving unkind people is hard. How is it possible? How did God show love for you when you were not-so-loveable?
