



## *Brave Part 9: "The Final Revelation"*

1. SPECIAL NOTE: In the message, Pastor Dan reminded us that at Faith Church we want to foster an environment where it's okay not to have all the answers and to ask lots of questions and we can also be confident that we will find most, if not all, the answers in God's word. Discuss as a group how you can continue to get better at doing this.
2. The visions in Daniel 10, 11, and 12 describe an invisible realm with spiritual forces at play. How does this perspective on spiritual warfare align with or challenge your understanding of what's going on in the world today? (See also Ephesians 6:10-20, 2 Corinthians 10:3-6, 1 Peter 5:8-9)
3. Read Daniel 12:1. How can you be sure that your name is written in the Book of Life? Share Bible passages that confirm this truth.
4. The prophecy in Daniel 12 speaks of a time of distress and the resurrection of the dead. How can this message of resurrection hope influence the way you approach difficulties in your own life?
5. Read Daniel 12:13. The messenger encouraged Daniel not to be overwhelmed by the visions but to go his way, live in faith, and await his allotted inheritance. Think of someone you're close to who could use a similar encouragement and reach out to them.



1. What does forgiveness mean?
2. Is it easy or hard to forgive? Why do you think so?
3. Why do you think Joseph chose to forgive his brothers?
4. Why did God choose to forgive us? How did he forgive us?
5. Is there someone you need to forgive right now? Pray to God for His Spirit of forgiveness. Thank Him for forgiveness through Jesus and the power to share that forgiveness with people in your life who have hurt you.
