2. Read Matthew 21:1-11. Discuss the significance of Jesus' triumphal entry for the people of that day.
 - a. Discuss its significance for us right now.

3. In verse 10 the question was asked about Jesus, "Who is this?" and to this day there are varying opinions. But Jesus can only be what he has revealed himself to be, and one of those things is our King. Wrestle together with this question: What does it mean then that Jesus is the king of your...
 - a. Political Views?
 - b. Religious Traditions?
 - c. National Identity?

4. The people were singing verses from Psalm 118. Read that psalm together and discuss any verses that might stand out to you.
