 - a. Is Jesus saying we should never be discerning or use our judgement? Explain. (see 1 Corinthians 5:1-12)
- 4. Since Jesus is the ultimate judge, what is our responsibility in God's kingdom according to Matthew 28:18-20, 2 Timothy 2:23-26, & 2 Timothy 4:1-5?
