- Read Colossians 3:5-11. What from these verses convict you? What from these verses give you hope?
- Read Colossians 3:12-15. Any time God encourages us to get rid of bad behaviors, he always encourages us to replace them with good ones. And the only way we can do any of that is by the power of Jesus' Spirit living in us. Which of the Holy Spirit empowered behaviors in this list stand out to you the most and why?

- Where can you *SEE* Jesus in the story of Paul?
- What can you do when you don't understand the Bible or a story it contains?
