3. How can "God knows everything" be both terrifying and our greatest treasure?
4. Read 1 John 3:23-24. What from these verses stands out to you and why?
5. Love in these verses is described as Jesus Christ laying down his life for us. How does the reality of God's love for you and me empower us to live sacrificially for others?
6. How can you be more intentional about having your love for others not just be spoken, but shown in action and in truth?
