



Galatians Part 1: "No Other Gospel"

1. Read Galatians 1:6-7. Paul expresses his astonishment that the Galatians were quickly deserting the gospel of Christ for a different one. What are some characteristics of the true gospel according to Paul? Why is it important to recognize and adhere to the true gospel?

2. Read Galatians 1:8-9. Paul warned against anyone preaching a gospel contrary to what they received, even if it were an angel from heaven. What does this tell us about the seriousness of preserving the purity of the gospel message?
 - a. How can we discern and guard against false teachings today?

3. In verse 10, Paul states that if he were still trying to please man, he would not be a servant of Christ. How do you see the tension between pleasing God and pleasing people in your own life? What steps can you take to ensure your primary allegiance is to God rather than human approval?

4. Considering the issues Paul addresses in these verses, what parallels can you draw to challenges the modern church faces today? How can the church stay faithful to the gospel message amidst cultural and doctrinal pressures?
