LIFE VERSE: Acts 1:8

1. What stands out to you about Jesus’ ongoing work or what questions do you have concerning Acts 1:1-3?
2. Read Acts 1:4-5 and 1 Corinthians 12. How would you describe the difference between the Spirit’s saving work and His empowering presence in our lives?
3. Read Acts 1:6-8. Jesus shifts the disciples’ focus from national restoration to their calling as His witnesses. How do you see this tension reflected in modern-day faith communities?
 - a. What are some ways we can remain faithful to Christ’s mission to be His witnesses instead of getting distracted by lesser priorities?
4. Read Acts 1:9-12. How does Jesus’ ascension into heaven strengthen your trust in God’s plan?
5. What connections do you see between Jesus’ promise of sending the Holy Spirit and the nature of the Trinity? (See John 4:15-31, John 15:26-27, John 16:1-15)?
